#### **Disposition of Minutes**

Corrections to minutes were noted and will be corrected. Joe Colonero made a motion to approve minutes with corrections, motion passed.

#### **Old Business**

Joe Bahm reported that the Knights donated \$1500 to the Pregnancy Care Center for the Mobile Center and \$500 to ST. Boniface outreach for \$10 gift cards for Thanksgiving baskets.

The Knights will sponsor breakfast Jan. 17 between 8 and 11 Masses

Ministry Fair – Deadline for contacting people who signed up is Nov. 15 and Stewardship members will begin calling the list after the 15<sup>th</sup> to see if there are any questions.

Chicken dinner update – 1500 chickens cooked. 750 went to the needy. The \$4700 profit went to debt reduction.

The oyster roast was well attended and profitable.

Breakfast with St. Nick is scheduled for Sat., Dec. 12. The Knights will be cooking and the party starts at 9.

The Dunking Booth will be put off until the spring.

Penance service Dec. 2 at 7 PM

Christmas Mass Schedule – 24<sup>th</sup>, 5 PM family mass and midnight mass, Christmas day 10 AM mass. Vigil mass on 31<sup>st</sup> at 5 PM and 10 AM mass on the first.

The children's orchestra will perform on the 23<sup>rd</sup> at 7

Defibrillator training to be determined. Austin looked up requirements and the pads have to be changed every 2 years and the battery every 4 years.

A new range will be purchased for the old faith formation kitchen. Father will look into having cabinets built in that kitchen

Security cameras – Father stated that everything has been researched and the cost will be approximately \$1,200 for 8 – 12 cameras. This project is on hold until finances are available.

Father stated that he wants to post pictures of Parish Council and Finance Committee members on the bulletin board in the church vestibule. It was suggested that members of these committees and Stewardship wear name tags at masses and parish functions. Lorraine will order the badges. Pictures and badges will help parishioners know who to speak with regarding issues.

Stewardship will sponsor 7 Steps to Financial Freedom in Jan.

At the last Stewardship meeting Emma suggested that 2 questions could be printed in the bulletin every week and the following Sun. the answers could be given at mass. This would give parishioners the opportunity to research answers and everyone would benefit. Father is trying to determine how best to implement.
