**Town Hall Meeting**

Parish Council must decide which direction to go in planning for the future expansion of the parish building. Please note that when discussing the Sanctuary, this is a 350 seat building with a large lobby. The 6 options discussed with the parish members are

1. Build the new Sanctuary and Father remains off campus.
  - a. Pros Discussed- Focus on one thing at a time.
  - b. Cons Discussed- Continue to pay rent of \$1100 a month. Father is off campus
2. Build the new Sanctuary and a new rectory on the property, continue to use the old rectory for offices and meeting rooms.
  - a. Pros Discussed- Father back on grounds. Next priest will have a new Rectory. More flexibility to build later. New Rectory does not have to be built by a commercial builder at about \$300.00 per square ft like the Sanctuary but could be built by a residential builder at about \$100.00 per square ft.
  - b. Cons Discussed- Have lots of “houses” on grounds already and this would add another.
3. Build the new Sanctuary and new office/meeting multipurpose building and Father would return to the existing rectory.
  - a. Pros Discussed- Building all at one time to keep cost down. Multipurpose building can be used as classrooms as needed for growth of the Faith Formation Program.
  - b. Cons Discussed- Take more money and the less can be spent on the Sanctuary. Has to have a commercial builder.
4. Build the new Sanctuary, a rectory and the office/meeting building
  - a. Pros Discussed- Building all at one time to keep cost down. Multipurpose building can be used as classrooms as needed for growth of the Faith Formation Program. Possible sale of the old rectory
  - b. Cons Discussed- Take more money and the less can be spent on the Sanctuary.
5. Build new rectory and continue to use the old rectory for offices and meeting rooms. Do not build new Sanctuary.
  - a. Pros Discussed- None
  - b. Con Discussed- Parish would like a new Sanctuary
6. Build a metal Parish Hall and convert current hall into a Sanctuary
  - a. Pros Discussed- Least expensive
  - b. Con Discussed- Difficult to get Bishop Hartmeyer to agree

**After discussion Parish Council unanimously picked option 2**
