At 7:09PM Polo opened the meeting with the Stewardship Prayer.

The February 6, 2018 minutes were approved as written, motion by Gerry and second by Carolynn.

Council Formation: Emma Shared very interesting information about an unlikely Saint, St. Ignatius of Loyola, we learned about his life, turning point, transformation, Daily Exam and spiritual exercises and ways of prayer.

Bible Study: Polo showed a few options from different websites: Word on Fire, Lighthouse Catholic Media, St Paul Center and the Augustine Institute. At this point the program "Catholicism" already owned by the parish might be the choice for the next one and Polo will explore it further to determine what is required.

Reflection Booklets: we need to talk to Fr. about booklets for the start of the liturgical year or for Advent.

New Business:

+ Emma mentioned she wants to show a video at 3PM on Sunday April 8 regarding the Divine Mercy Sunday. She will talk to Pattie to include in the announcements and in the bulletin.

+ A new discussion took place about the ministry Fair and the effectiveness versus the work involved; an option came up in the intention of making a survey to get feedback from the parishioners but it has to be detailed and specific. Gerry said she has an example from another parish and will share it. Polo will explore different formats also.

Closing Prayer-Reflection: Polo closed the meeting with a reflection on Jesus suffering on the cross.
