- * Meeting was opened at 7:09 with the Stewardship Prayer.
- * Minutes were approved as corrected.
- * Emma's Council Formation was about St. Luke since this is his Feast day. He was of Greek origin and lived to be 84 years old. She also shared about Alan Hunt who authored Confessions of a Mega Church Pastor. She enlightened us about the tragedy of Human Trafficking that is happening in Savannah brought to her attention during Deanery Council event by Homeland Security.
- Pat spoke about the Ministry of Lectio Divina at October 1 & 2nd Masses.
Parish Outreach will be contacted to speak at Dec 3 & 4th Masses.
Nursery will be contacted to speak at January 7 & 8, 2017, Masses.
- Dolores suggested that with Loretta's Dahlweiner's permission, if David and Henry could be invited to talk about their ministry as Altar Servers and ministry in general.
- There was very poor attendance at the Ministry Fair Organizational meeting with the ministry leaders. Joe updated the chairmen with an email. We will do the printing of the pamphlets in black and white here at church if color is not available. The cost to have them printed is too high. Joe sent a letter to Pattie about how and amount of items to be printed. Pat and Dolores offered to help Pattie with the preparation of the paperwork. Ministry leaders can start setting up for the fair at 2pm Saturday, November 5th. Joe will get there early to set up tables. There were concerns about a couple of errors in the bulletin insert about the Ministry

Fair that need to be corrected through emails: Ministry Fair is inside not outside and number of booths to visit has been reduced.

A tear-off sheet is supposed to be in the bulletin this week-end for registration and announcements need to be made at each Mass also.
- Denise was concerned that the Stewardship prayer is not being said anymore at Mass and this needs to be revisited with Father.
- Our next meeting date was scheduled for November 15, which would allow for all commitment cards to be collected.
- Pat closed with a reflection for the little Burgundy book at 8:20pm.
