He also thinks it best that the house have 4 bedrooms and 3 baths and a room reserved for prayer. There should be a bedroom and bath for a guest. The home should be somewhere between 2000 – 2300 sq. ft. Robin Smith made a motion that was seconded by Lisa Ganser that the money should be taken from our building fund to buy the house and then it be reimbursed to the building fund. The motion passed. Robin Smith also made a motion and Lisa Ganser seconded that the cottage be rented to Fr.'s parents. Motion passed.
