New Business

Joe Cook gave a quick update about the parish finances and said that we are ahead of our projections at this time.

Fr. received a bill from Blessed Sacrament for two of our parish children that are attending there. We've never paid this amount before. One of the families are faithful members of our church. The other family left our church in May. We are going to pay the fee (\$1300.00) for the one child not the one whose family left our parish.

Fr. said that we also have been charged \$28000 by the Deanery but he wants to really look at this charge next year.

Father would like one of the parish groups to make a presentation to the parish council. Every group would have a chairperson and every chairperson will come to the parish council meeting and each council member will work with each group.

There is a priest coming for a day of recollection on leadership and stewardship for the parish council members in November. Obviously he would like us all to attend. Fr. added that he would also like to transform the leadership positions of the parish council and finance committee members.

We broke down all of the previous committees into new groups. Attached is the breakdown.

New confessional is coming the size will be 9 x 8 ft. with two comfy chairs and a screen.

Joe Colanero asked again about using computers for donations (on-line). That will be discussed again.
