Ministries Updates:

Committees:

Finance – Barbara Rafferty – estimate for the floor (In the 70's); we have the money for the parking lot; we discussed a building maintenance fund; every ministry needs to have the budget needs in – Barbara will give them one week to get it in and then she will start calling the different ministries. If they haven't spent it by the end of the year, it becomes the general fund. Pattie is sending out the email tomorrow – and they get one week from then. The finance committee will reconvene to determine the needs and the budget for everything.

Unfinished Business:

1) 7 Sisters Program – Tabled for now

2) Propane tank – Propane tank should be delivered on Saturday and be hooked up. Charline or Vicki needs to be here to light it up. Ron volunteered to come Saturday at 9:00 to get it lit. It is 120 gallon tank with a gauge on it. When the gas runs low, they will come fill it up. It will be \$150.00 for the tank rental and gauge for a year.

2) Parking Lot and Floors – Robin spoke to Fr. about the parking lot. The young man - Jeremy Hill - will draw up a plan. It will be 42,000 to 45,000 for the total and about 62 loads. He will do it in installments (or multiple trips). We need to have something in the bulletin (both the parking lot and the floors – the next two/three years project.) Parking lot will be first – but if we have the money we need to do it. Fr. will talk about the projects at mass the second week of Lent.

3) Repairs on Religious Education Building and Grounds – We have talked about doing it as a parish this summer. We need to get someone to do the corners where the tape is coming off. Maybe different families can be responsible for painting different rooms (could be summer family volunteers.) – Do it after Vacation Bible school in the summer. Could have the rooms all prepped with tarps on the floor, etc. – including all receptacle covers taken off, all materials out of the room.
